Soldiers’ Angels Project Valour-IT helps provide voice-controlled and adaptive laptop computers to military personnel recovering from severe injuries. Operating these laptops by speaking into a microphone or using other adaptive technologies, the wounded can send and receive messages from friends and loved ones, surf the Internet, and communicate with buddies still in the field.

Delivering over 2600 laptops so far, Valour-IT assists the wounded in reclaiming a bit of wholeness and independence in the face of life-altering injuries, repeated surgery, painful physical therapy, and the isolation of the hospital room. A high-quality laptop can help reestablish personal dignity and reconnect them with the world.

Every bit helps, and all funds will go directly to **Project Valour-IT** to purchase the laptop that helps provide independence and freedom to wounded Soldiers, Sailors, Airmen, and Marines as they recover.
