

HOW TO USE A SAND SCARF FROM SOLDIERS' ANGELS



Soldiers' Angels is providing sand scarves to you to help protect your troops from sand storms. They are custom-made by our volunteers and should come in handy.

A simple scarf may not sound like a big deal until you are in a 40-mile-per-hour wind with blowing sand in your face while trying to carry 30-50 pounds of gear on your back

and a weapon in your hand, and trying to keep the sand out of your mouth and nose and still keep your helmet on your head. The scarves should help keep the sand and dust from permeating every crevice on your head, keeping your hands free to do your job and your focus on your work.

You can place a sand scarf under a hat or helmet and keep your nose and mouth covered to keep the sand out (see the pictures for examples of how to wear the scarf). The sand scarf is 100% cotton so it will wash and wear well, and is desert tan in color so it will blend in well with uniforms currently worn.
