Variable Event Size

Sponsor and/or Volunteer

Monthly Event

Direct Support to Veteran Families

Provide support directly to homeless or at-risk veterans and their families. The event is organized in partnership with food banks in the city where the event is held.

Collect Needed Items

Packaging Event

You can also choose to purchase these items in bulk and host a company packaging project. Ship the completed packages to us, along with a postage donation, and we will send them to service members requesting our support.
