DEPLOYED SUPPORT



Soldiers' Angels Deployed Support Program supports service members deployed to combat zones around the world. Working virtually, volunteers send care packages, cards, letters, and even homemade baked goods. For many service members, the support provided by Soldiers' Angels is the only support they receive from home during their deployment.



VETERAN SUPPORT



Soldiers' Angels is one of the few nonprofit agencies with a voting seat on the Veterans Affairs (VA) National Advisory Council and approval to work within VA Hospitals. Angel volunteers work in VA Hospitals across the country to provide support to veterans of all eras. The program also supports low-income, homeless, and at-risk veterans and their families by providing food assistance, hygiene items, transportation assistance, and other critical needs.



FAMILY SUPPORT



The Soldiers' Angels Family Support Program ensures that military families have a shoulder to lean on. From providing direct support and telehealth services to military caregivers, to hosting virtual baby showers, and even assisting through the holidays by providing gifts for the children and a grocery gift card for the family's holiday meal, the Soldiers' Angels Family Support Program provides a wide range of services that offer a helping hand to military and veteran families.



WOUNDED SUPPORT



Soldiers' Angels Wounded Support Program provides support to service members being treated at the Landstuhl Regional Medical Center in Germany. In addition, through the Valor IT program, Soldiers' Angels provides voice-activated laptops to wounded heroes recovering from severe injuries.

IMPACT: SPIRIT

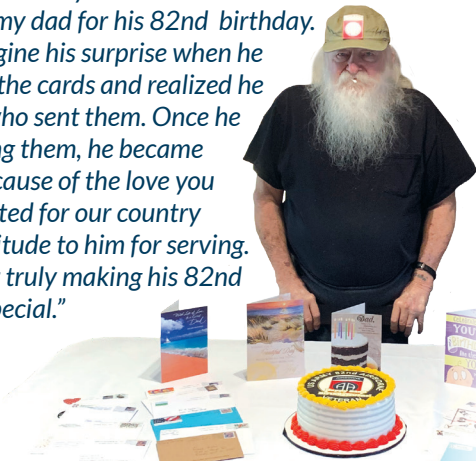
