What are Site Coordinators?

Site Coordinators are the super volunteers who register to be the main point of contact between the VA site, the Soldiers' Angels representatives (where present) and the Home of the Brave campaign. Among other responsibilities, Site Coordinators:

- Participate in planning meetings with Soldiers' Angels and coordinate with their VA
 Medical Center point of contact and the Soldiers' Angels point of contact (where present)
 to help plan a Veterans Day celebration at the VA facility;
- Recruit and coordinate company volunteers; and,
- Complete and submit an after-action report and photos detailing the celebration, volunteers, volunteer hours, and lessons learned.
